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

Nestled amidst river bluffs on the sharpest navigable bend on the Mississippi River, Red Wing presents the perfect mix of river town history, artistry, theatre, crafts – and great shoes, of course.

Red Wing is an antique and pottery lover's paradise, and also is home to dozens of one-of-a-kind clothing, gift and craft stores. From the beautiful downtown to the historic Pottery Place Mall, you'll find unique treasures to warm your heart and make you smile long after you've left. Culinary confections, candles, hand-blown glass and Scandinavian and German keepsakes all await personal discovery. And the famous Red Wing Shoes and Red Wing Stoneware are purchased and collected across the country.

The town boasts one of the finest small theatres in the Midwest. The community is devoted and beloved to the beautifully restored Sheldon Performing Arts Theatre (built in 1904), and welcomes the draw of nationally known acts.


In the Arts, the Red Wing Arts Association Gallery gives you your first glimpse of works by talented local artists. Natural history buffs and young history protégés are fascinated by the

Goodhue County Historical Center's exhibits. And welcome our recent addition to our long list of activities, the Falconer Vineyards Winery, now open for tours and tasting.

Red Wing's lodging leads the league in small-town lodging. The St James Hotel has provided the finest accommodations since 1875. None of its 61 guestrooms are alike, and each is named after a riverboat that used to pass through Red Wing. Seven charming motels provide travelers with more lodging options, and offer amenities you might not expect.

More importantly, Red Wing is much more than good shoes. It's great people.

Historic Rivertown, with Cheery Old-Fashioned Small Town Hospitality



Little more than a stones-throw apart, Wabasha and Kellogg are two of the oldest towns on the upper Mississippi.

Wabasha was populated in 1826, and Kellogg shortly thereafter. Because of their history and close proximity to the Mississippi River, these communities offer a variety of activities including boating, sailing, golf, downhill skiing, and miles of hiking trails with some of the most incredible birding in the country.

Eagles gather in numbers during the winter months and nest in the charming town year round. The National Eagle Center houses three live eagles, (Angel, Harriet, & Columbia). Many visitors travel to Wabasha-Kellogg to have a "Nose to Beak" experience with America's National Symbol of Freedom – *The American Bald Eagle*.

Enjoy the river with Great River Houseboats, pontoons, riverboat dinner cruises on the Julia Belle Swain, and moonlight sailboat rides on The Messenger. More attractions for visitors and groups include Arrowhead Bluffs Museum, and The Jon Hassler Theater.

Fun, unique, and cultural, all describe what you will experience while shopping and visiting

L.A.R.K. Carousel & Antique Toy Museum, Bouquet Outlet Store, and the Wind Whisper West Kimono Gallery.


Free concerts under the bridge in downtown Wabasha on Friday evenings along with riverfront horse-drawn wagon and carriage rides are another local entertainment option you can discover during your stay.

Historic Island City: A River Town Flowing with Culture



Winona is the southernmost of Minnesota's great Mississippi River towns on the scenic Great River Road. Founded by steamboat captain Orrin Smith in 1851, Winona's gateway location on the Mississippi River made it a primary transportation hub and one of the nation's richest cities by 1900. Many historic buildings and beautiful vintage homes echo the legacy, portraying Winona's ongoing harmony with the river to this day.

Known as the "Stained Glass Capital" of the United States, the city has studios that restore, repair, design, and create stained-glass pieces for buildings nationwide.

But it's not all about glass. The Winona County Historical Museum, Watkins Museum and Store, Polish Museum, Pickwick Mill, and the Minnesota Marine Art Museum all have historical and cultural memories that are unforgettable.

Don't miss a visit to Garvin Heights Overlook for a truly breathtaking panoramic view of the river valley, shop the downtown for unique gifts, or stroll Levee Park to view the gigantic barges. A new addition to our

attractions is Garvin Heights Vineyards, open for tastings and tours.

Outdoor enthusiasts find that Winona is "heaven on earth." Headquarters to the Upper Mississippi River National Wildlife and Fish Refuge, popular activities range from canoeing to horseback riding, snowmobiling to cross-country skiing.

Winona also is home to the Great River Shakespeare Festival, Minnesota Beethoven Festival, Gilmore Creek Summer Theatre, and Frozen River Film Festival. Classic stage performances at Saint Mary's University, and Winona State University, concerts through Theatre du Mississippi, and art exhibits are thriving; and talented local artists and musicians contribute to the lively arts culture.

Winona truly is a treasure-filled destination. Come discover this great town and its people for yourself.

A Valley Deep in Art, Culture and Beauty



Nestled in the valley of the Root River, Lanesboro offers tourists invigorating outdoor activities, rich artistic experiences, unique shopping, a local winery, fine dining and lodging to fit every taste and budget.

Besides receiving the *Great American Main Street Award* in 1998, Lanesboro was named one of *100 Best Small Art Towns in America* by author John Villani and one of the *50 Best Outdoor Sports Towns* by Sports Afield magazine. Outside magazine featured Lanesboro, Minnesota as one of the *20 Best Dream Towns in America* to live and play!

In Lanesboro, the arts thrive. Extraordinary exhibits appear year round at the **Cornucopia Art Center**, featuring a variety of regional artists. The Lanesboro Art Council programs more than a half dozen musical concerts a year in the **St. Mane Theatre**. More than 20,000 people attend live professional theatre at the acclaimed **Commonweal Theatre Company**, and when summer comes back around Lanesboro's own homegrown radio variety show, *Over the Back Fence*, is broadcast live on Sunday nights.

Biking lovers rave about the spectacular

paved Root River State Bike Trail that winds 60 miles through the valley with Lanesboro at its heart. It runs along an abandoned railroad bed through high bluffs, forestlands, rolling fields and pure inspiration.

Enjoy the beauty and charm of downtown Lanesboro in class with a romantic horse drawn carriage ride, or relaxing Trolley Tour.

For old-fashioned fun and traditions, attend one of our annual festivals including the Stand-Still Parade each May, Rhubarb Festival each June, Art in the Park on Father's Day, Buffalo Bill Days in August, Fall Fest in October and Winterfest each February.



STATE PARKS

Carley State Park – Birding, fishing, hunting, camping, picnic areas, hiking and Cross-Country skiing.

Forestville State Park – Visit Forestville/Mystery Cave State Park to see natural wonders above and below ground.

Frontenac State Park – 2300 acre park overlooking Lake Pepin with Camping, hunting, Birding, Fishing, picnicking, trails, cc skiing, snowmobiling, and a winter sliding hill.

Great River Bluffs State Park – Two Scientific and Natural Areas, King's and Queen's Bluff, offers excellent hiking, diversity of wildlife and breathtaking views of the Mississippi River Valley.

John A Latsch State Park – 350 acre park offers camping, hunting, picnic areas, a half mile trail leading to the top of Mt Charity overlooking the Mississippi River

Kellogg-Waver Dunes SNA – Contains rolling and dune topography, Some dunes are 30 feet high. Great place for birding & wildlife viewing.

Kruger State Park – Offers wheelchair accessible trail, fishing, hunting, hiking trails, canoe access, picnic area, with shelters nature trails and campsites.

Reick's Lake Park – See Tundra Swans on an observation deck or spotting scopes. Best time to visit Mid to Late November.

Snake Creek Mgmt Area – ATVs and Motorcycles are permitted May 1st to November 1st. Snowmobiles are permitted December 1st to March 31st. Skiing and Hiking permitted. Picnic Tables and Toilet Facilities.

Tiffany Bottoms Wildlife Area – 12,500 acres of walking trails, birding, wildlife viewing, hunting, hiking and camping available.

Whitewater State Park – 2,700 acre park with camping, hiking, hunting, swimming beach, cc skiing, with visitor center and rentals.

Zumbro Bottoms Horse Trails – Trails for hiking, hunting, canoeing, & horseback riding.


